School uniform expectations reminder for January 2018

Dear Parent/Carer

We are contacting you in order to solicit your support in ensuring that your child is dressed in accordance with the school's uniform policy for the start of the new calendar year in January.

It is expected that all students are in the correct uniform when they start back in the Spring term. As there is now a long holiday, any uniform issues can be resolved by you and you have an opportunity buy any necessary uniform.

If students are not in the correct uniform in January, the student may be asked to wear spare uniform and may be placed in isolation if the student refuses or the uniform issue is not resolved quickly (the time period allowed is usually a week at most). This is in line with our school uniform policy, which can be found on the school website.

Could we please remind you of the following points:

- The full school uniform should be worn, including grey trouser or skirt from the online uniform suppliers and ties for boys and for girls, if a shirt collar is worn
- No makeup or jewellery is permitted
- If false nails or nail varnish are applied during the holidays, this must be removed before your child returns in January
- Only formal, black leather shoes are allowed and no black trainers or plimsoll type shoes made of canvas or black leather are allowed to be worn in school
- Hoodies and sports jackets are not to be worn on school site, in the cold winter months it is expected that students wear a coat and the official school jumper if they are cold
